ASSOCIATE MEMBER FLIGHTS				No Charge	A Member who is an instructor may fly an Associate Member during his turn, or when a two-seater is available, at no additional cost to the member.

DEFINITIONS

CATEGORY	DEFINITION
MEMBER	Fully paid up member of the DSC. (Full Member)
ASSOCIATE MEMBER	Additional fees paid by a Member who wishes to bring along a partner or family member on a regular basis. Members' children are free of charge up to 12 years old, after which they are treated as Associate Members while dependent. Thereafter, they need to become Members in their own right.
JUNIOR MEMBER	A Member who is a minor engaged in full time study at school or tertiary institute. Thereafter FULL membership
VISITOR	Applies to any occasional member of the public who seeks an introductory flight and or uses the club facilities. No visitors, whether private or family will be allowed to have access unless a member is present.
GUEST	Any person (including spouse, companion etc) occasionally invited by a Member whose account is in good
VISITING PILOT	Any bona fide member of a gliding club flies at normal club rates providing he has a valid SSSA membership. Visiting Pilots fly dual in club aircraft, with a club Member having a GPL .
